- Tell others what you learned at One Earth
 Film Fest: word of mouth, social media, in an op-ed or letter to the editor
- Watch/rewatch past One Earth Film Fest films (<u>here</u> and <u>here</u>) & discussions (<u>here</u>, <u>here</u>, and <u>here</u>)
- Change your mindset: Everything you do is related to the ecosystem!
- Spend more time in nature
- Join an eco- or climate justice group in your community
- Lend support & resources to BIPOC and low-income communities disproportionately impacted by our climate crisis
- Consume less. Reuse. By in bulk. Avoid packaging. Don't buy "single use" items
- Reduce food waste, ensure that food scraps get composted
- Participate in, or start, a composting program in your city or town
- Learn more about Chicago's first residential composting program & find a nearby garden!
- Participate in <u>plasticfreejuly.org</u>

- Support small businesses working to minimize waste, source local, and provide local benefits
- Learn where your garbage goes and if it's polluting the environment. EPA'S Environmental Justice Screening And Mapping Tool <u>epa.gov/ejscreen</u>
- <u>Support Earthbound's Nzambi Matee & Gjenge</u> <u>Makers</u> turning plastic into building bricks
- Be a customer rather than a consumer. Aim to buy products that have or could have a second or third life. Ask yourself: *what will happen to this product when I no longer have a need for it?*
- Use REUSABLE bottles, bags, straws, utensils, etc.
- Be a leader: build a network, create content, join a board, run for office
- Contact your legislators with a letter or group letter & VOTE for candidates with strong environmental platforms
- Ask your legislators to support legislation banning foam foodware and plastic carryout bags. In Illinois: <u>ilenviro.org/a/plastic-foam-ban</u>
- In IL, join the IEC <u>May 15 Zero Waste Lobby Day</u>
- Draw down carbon through <u>bioplastics</u>, <u>recycling</u>, and <u>coastal wetland protection</u>
